



Readings for Jan 9, 2022 The Baptism of the Lord

Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7 (alt. Isa 40:1-5, 9-11)

Behold my servant with whom I am well pleased.

Psalm 29:1-2, 3-4, 3, 9-10

The Lord will bless his people with peace.

Acts of the Apostles 10:34-38 (alt. Titus 2:11-14; 3:4-7) God anointed him with the Holy Spirit.

Luke 3:15-16, 21-22

When Jesus had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened.

Reflection

This is the first instance of God expanding the Abrahamic covenant beyond the Israelites. For nearly two thousand years, the Hebrews have been God's chosen people. Now, with the arrival of Jesus, the promise of God's kingdom expands to include all of humanity. This is modeled to us when the emissaries from a completely different country arrive to honor him and claim Jesus as their Lord too.

The Star Shines On

Those who have tried to follow the Creator of the stars often find themselves in the midst of an Epiphany. They are called to follow stars that seem beyond their reach.

Once a mother whose son had been murdered saw a star that said, "Forgive." The star led her to a prison, to the murderer. The light of the star enabled her to discover within her own heart a mercy she didn't know she possessed. The mercy belonged to the Creator of the stars but it was hers to use when she was in need. She used it well.

There was another woman who had an Epiphany that wouldn't stop. The star she saw shone right into the hearts of the poor. The compassionate ministry that continues in the Catholic Worker houses has turned Dorothy Day into a star that keeps on shining. . . .

Martin Luther King, Jr., saw a star that is still shining. It was a star of hope for those who were suffering from the oppression and evil of racism and prejudice. He followed that star to his death. He is the patron saint of those who find it hard to follow stars.

And then, there was that man of God from San Salvador. His name? Oscar Romero! He was elevated to the office of archbishop because it was believed he would be a safe, middle-of-the-road person, one who keeps peace by being silent. Perhaps that is who Oscar used to be, but everything changed one day. He had an Epiphany. He saw a star of truth that shone straight through all the lies, impelling him to speak out against injustice. He spoke. He died. His star shines on.

And you? You must add your own names to this list.

Holy Cross will be hosting a small group (geared toward adults) to watch, discuss, and truly benefit and grow from experiencing *The Search*.


