Age-group classes meet every weekend. This works by spreading the classroom times between morning (8:45am) & afternoon (12:15pm) sessions.

Sundays 9:45am (K-5) and 12:15pm (grades 6+)

Teachers lead age-cohort classes every weekend.

Parents volunteer, teach / co-teach, or attend adult faith formation classes while their children are in class.



FAQ: What about classroom space?


